The Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (GoSVG) has received financing from the International Development Association (The World Bank) and the European Commission towards the Volcano Eruption Emergency Project (VEEP). The Project Development Objective of the VEEP is to support Saint Vincent and the Grenadines to (i) provide short-term income support, (ii) improve the capacity of the government to prepare for and respond to emergencies, and (iii) build back better critical services in the aftermath of the La Soufriere volcano eruption. The VEEP comprises three components that seek to achieve the development objectives. To facilitate the proper execution of the Project, the Government of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines is recruiting Junior Engineers to provide technical support to the Ministry of Transport, Works, Lands and Physical Planning (MoTW) and, to assist the Project Implementation Unit (PIU) in implementing activities under the Project.

The position of Junior Engineer is a contracted full-time position. Work will be performed at the office of the Engineering Department in the Ministry of Transport, Works, Lands and Physical Planning. The Junior Engineer will report to the Chief Engineer through the Senior Engineers and shall be responsible for assisting with the infrastructure aspects of the VEEP under the direct supervision of the Chief Engineer. The Engineer will work closely with the Engineering team at the MoTW and will liaise with the PIU to ensure that the project activities are conducted according to the Government of SVG and World Bank requirements.
